Greetings to All~

QSC has exciting news to share with our Service Provider Network!

A new 90L Form has been issued that is to be used <u>immediately</u> for all Waiver Populations-NOW, CCW, Supports and ROW. However, please read below for how to use the form based on the waiver population that it is being completed for.

OCDD has changed some rules regarding the 90L:

- 1. NOW Waiver- a Nurse Practitioner (NP) or Physician Assistant (PA) is now allowed to sign off on the 90L.
- 2. Children's Choice Waiver, Supports Waiver and ROW a Medical Doctor MUST sign off on the 90L. A Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant CANNOT SIGN OFF ON THE 90L.

Please note the following changes on the new 90L:

- Page 1, Section II, Level of Care- Must be marked "A" ICF/ID.
 -this is the only option that can be marked for participants to be eligible for Waiver services.
- 2. The question asking, "If the participant is likely to need to be hospitalized for more than 30 consecutive days" has been removed.
- 3. Page 2, Section III- Labelled I. (at the bottom)- if a Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant completes and signs the 90L then the name of the Medical Doctor that supervises the NP or PA needs to be written down on the first line.

QSC is asking that we all work together to help make our families and medical personnel more familiar with this new 90L.

Please remember that there are no other changes to how the 90L is completed. Diagnoses, medications and a physical exam must be listed on the 90L. If the Doctor/NP/PA does a "see attached sheet" for medications, or other things it should be signed by the Doctor/NP/PA.

Attached you will find the new 90L, instructions for filling out the 90L, and a letter to medical personnel about what the 90L is.
